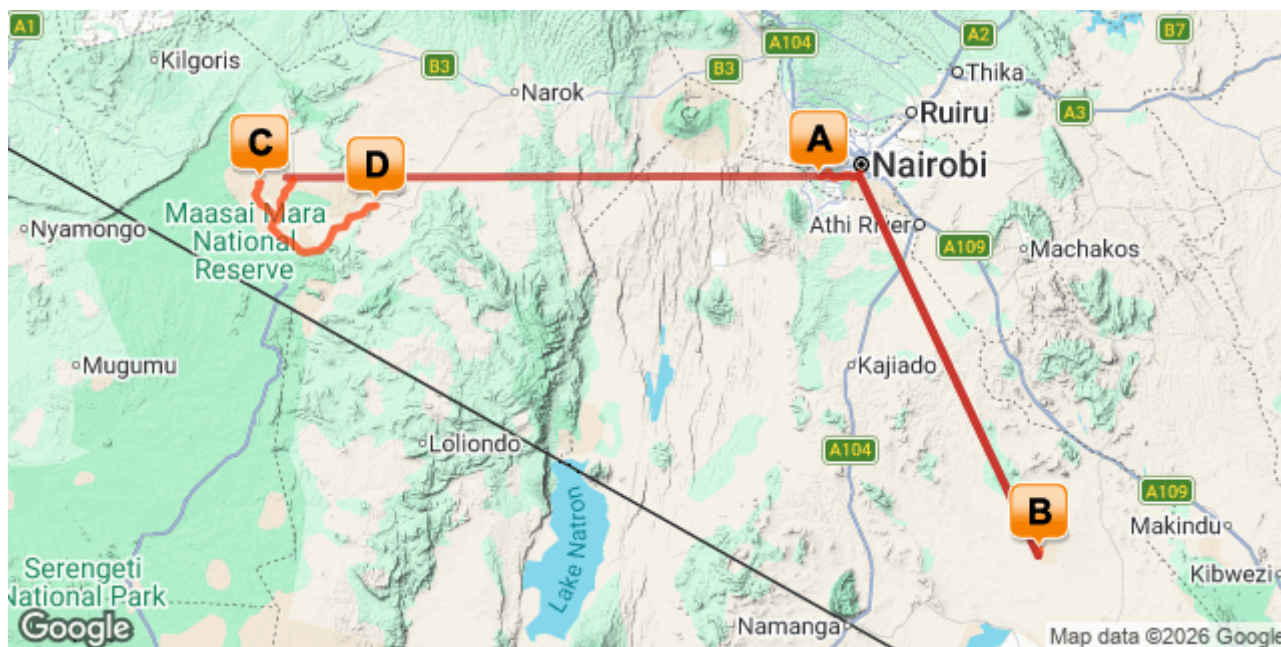

Day 1: Nairobi Tented Camp, Nairobi (Tue, 13 October)

Nairobi

Situated along the Nairobi River in beautiful Kenya, the capital of Nairobi is East Africa's most cosmopolitan city. It serves as an excellent starting point for African safari trips around Kenya. Nairobi is Africa's 4th largest city and is a vibrant and exciting place to be. There are some fascinating attractions: its cafe culture, unbridled nightlife, the National Museum, the Karen Blixen Museum and most notably, just 20 minutes from the city centre, wild lions and buffalo roam in the world's only urban National Park. Make sure you pay a visit to the elephant orphanage operated by the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust for a once in a lifetime experience.

Day Itinerary

Welcome to Kenya.

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be warmly met by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Nairobi. Depending on your arrival time, the rest of the day is at leisure to relax and recover from your journey. Nairobi offers a gentle introduction to East Africa, blending urban energy with lush green spaces and a rich safari heritage.

Set within a peaceful natural environment on the outskirts of the city, Nairobi Tented Camp provides a unique bush-style experience while still conveniently close to the city and airports, allowing you to begin your safari in a tranquil setting.

Nestled within the lush woodlands of Karen, Nairobi Tented Camp offers a tranquil retreat where nature's rhythms set the pace of life. The air is crisp with the scent of damp earth, carrying the calls of birds and the occasional rustle of small wildlife such as bush babies, tree hyraxes and monkeys moving through the trees.

Carefully positioned between the trees, the canvas tents blend seamlessly with the environment, offering a sense of seclusion and 'safari' without sacrificing comfort.

This hidden gem in Karen provides a perfect balance of adventure and tranquility, a place where guests can immerse themselves in nature while remaining just a short distance from Nairobi's bustling city centre.

Day 2: Porini Amboseli Camp, Selenkay Conservancy (Wed, 14 October)

Selenkay Conservancy

Situated in magical Kenya, just north of Amboseli over the northern boundary of Amboseli Park is the Selenkay Conservancy. Selenkay shares the same ecosystem as Amboseli and is established on lands leased from the local Maasai, with the aim of protecting the wildlife habitat and encouraging wildlife conservation. The conservancy is home to an array of wildlife such as elephant, gazelle, lion, giraffe cheetah, leopard, mongoose, porcupine, yellow baboon and bat-eared fox. It boasts a remote bush camp in the heart of Selenkay's Maasailand which is the perfect spot from which to view the plentiful of wildlife. Visitors can enjoy close encounters with wildlife, day and night game drives, guided bush walks with experienced, knowledgeable Maasai guides and visiting a local Maasai village.

Day Itinerary

An early morning pick-up at 06:30 will see you transferred to Wilson Airport for your scheduled flight south toward Amboseli.

Flight: Nairobi – Selenkay

ETD 07:00 / ETA 07:45

Upon arrival at Selenkay Airstrip, you will be met by your guide and transferred to Porini Amboseli Camp, located within the exclusive Selenkay Conservancy, a private wilderness area bordering Amboseli National Park.

This remarkable ecosystem is famous for its large elephant herds and breathtaking views of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain.

After settling into camp and enjoying lunch, you may head out for your first safari activity. The conservancy offers an intimate and exclusive safari experience with opportunities for game drives, guided walks, and cultural interactions with the Maasai community.

Porini Amboseli Camp is small and is on the lines of the traditional luxury safari camp, but with more comfortable bathroom arrangements than were available to the big game hunters of earlier years. The camp facilities include 10 spacious guest tents, comfortably furnished with en suite bathrooms including shower, wash basin and flush toilet and solar power electric lighting. The camp provides an exclusive experience catering to a maximum of 18 guests at a time with all meals, drinks (wine, gin & tonic, beer, sodas, mineral water). All activities including game drives, walks, night drives and sundowners are included in the price and transport on this safari is in a specially designed open-sided Landrover 4 wheel drive safari vehicle. Going on safari in a 'proper' safari vehicle gives a far better safari experience than travelling in the minibus vans with window seats used by other tour operators. And as Selenkay Conservation Area is a private game reserve, you will not see any other vehicles or minibuses.

Day 3: Porini Amboseli Camp, Selenkay Conservancy (Thu, 15 October)

Day Itinerary

Today is dedicated to exploring the magnificent Amboseli National Park, one of Africa's most iconic safari destinations.

You will enjoy a full-day excursion into the park, renowned for its vast open plains, seasonal swamps, and some of the best elephant viewing in Africa. Amboseli is particularly famous for its impressive tusked elephants, often seen against the dramatic backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro.

The park is home to a rich variety of wildlife including elephants, lions, cheetahs, buffalo, giraffes, hyenas, zebras, wildebeest, and an impressive diversity of birdlife.

A picnic or bush lunch allows you to maximize your time in the park before returning to camp later in the day.

Day 4: Porini Lion Camp, Olare Motorogi Conservancy (Fri, 16 October)

Olare Motorogi Conservancy

The Olare Motorogi Conservancy is an 85 square kilometre expanse of prime private wilderness in southwest Kenya; part of the Maasai Mara-Serengeti ecosystem and wildlife dispersal zone. The conservancy lies immediately to the northwest of the main Maasai Mara Reserve. Tourism is limited to a maximum of 94 beds which maximizes the client's wilderness experience and minimizes the environmental impact of tourism. Open hills provide a habitat for a diverse range of grazers, including giraffes, zebras, hartebeests, and warthogs. These herds attract large numbers of predators, including lions, cheetahs, hyenas, and jackals. In between the hills run a number of small seasonal streams, fringed by stretches of forest which are home to a broader range of species including baboons, elephants, buffaloes, hippos, and leopards.

Day Itinerary

After an early breakfast, transfer to Selenkay Airstrip for your return flight to Nairobi.

Flight: Selenkay – Nairobi

ETD 08:00 / ETA 08:45

Upon arrival at Wilson Airport, connect with your onward scheduled flight to the Maasai Mara.

Flight: Nairobi – Mara (Ola)

ETD 10:30 / ETA 11:10

Upon landing in the Mara, you will be met by your guide and transferred to Porini Lion Camp, located in the exclusive Olare Motorogi Conservancy.

This conservancy is widely regarded as one of the finest wildlife areas in the greater Mara ecosystem, particularly renowned for excellent predator sightings and exclusive game-viewing with fewer vehicles.

After lunch and some time to settle in, enjoy an afternoon game drive searching for lions, cheetahs, leopards, elephants, and abundant plains game.

Porini Lion Camp is located in unique and stunning setting on the banks of the seasonal Ntiakatiak River within the Olare Motorogi Conservancy. This large area borders the Maasai Mara National Reserve and is home to an abundance of animals including the Mara's renowned Big Cats. There is unsurpassed game-viewing within the conservancy due to its unspoiled natural state and the Porini Lion Camp – with just ten tents including two family units – ensures guests have a genuine "away from it all" experience deep in the African bush. The Olare Motorogi Conservancy ensures a true wilderness experience with one of the lowest tourist densities in the Mara region and the highest lion densities. The only safari vehicles allowed are the few 4x4s related to the 5 small camps within this vast area and there is a rich and diverse wildlife population with good numbers of predators and herbivores.

Day 5: Porini Ol Kinyei Safari Cottages, Ol Kinyei Conservancy (Sat, 17 October)

Ol Kinyei Conservancy

As one of the sixteen conservancies that are part of the renowned Maasai Mara, the Ol Kinyei Conservancy is a pristine wilderness area characterised by open savannah plains, riverine forests, springs, rivers, and rolling hills. The conservancy is inhabited by a wide variety of animal species for which the Mara is famous including lion, leopard, cheetah, giraffe, and wild dog. The wildebeest migration also passes through Ol Kinyei when herds from the eastern plains of Loita join the migration to the Mara Reserve. An impressive array of bird species also inhabit the park, including grey crowned crane and some exciting endemic species. Visitors can look forward to morning, evening, and late-night game drives guided walks with expert local Maasai guides and drinking sundowners at a number of scenic points within the conservancy.

Day Itinerary

After breakfast, transfer from Porini Lion Camp to Porini Ol Kinyei Safari Cottages, located in the beautiful Ol Kinyei Conservancy.

The transfer itself is a safari experience, with opportunities for wildlife sightings en route as you move through different habitats of the greater Mara ecosystem.

Ol Kinyei is one of the most exclusive conservancies in the Mara, known for its pristine wilderness, exceptional wildlife density, and intimate safari atmosphere.

After arrival and lunch, the remainder of the day is at leisure or may include a game drive, guided walk, or sundowner experience.

The Porini Ol Kinyei Safari Cottages are your home away from home in the world renowned Maasai Mara offering every comfort with the distinct warm service of the Maasai and an unbeaten wildlife experience.

A unique "home away from home" with stunning views across the Mara in the only IUCN Green List Protected area in the Mara eco-system with some of the highest big cat densities and the location of the annual Loita wildebeest

calving every year in February and March, with the local community members who know this land intimately as your hosts.

Each of the 4 four-bedroom safari high end safari cottages is on a hillside location with spectacular views over the open plains below. There is a large wildlife dam down from the cottages which is a big draw for wildlife including lions and elephants. The cottages are designed to maximize on these views whilst minimizing the visual impact from the plains.

Each Cottage has four spacious bedrooms, all with private bathroom en-suites. A common lounge with a fireplace for the cold evenings and media room for kids to have a place to unwind, remote working, reviewing and editing the days photography and so much more.

Whether enjoying early morning game drives, sundowners overlooking the plains, or quiet moments at camp listening to the sounds of the African bush, today promises memorable safari experiences.
